- Use eye contact and tell them to go awav.
- **TELL SOMEONE.**

DON'T:-



- Do what they say.
- Get angry.
- Hit them.
- Think it is your fault.
- Hide it.

- School Behaviour Policy promotes positive behaviour
- PHSE lessons & circle time activities
- School posters remind children bullying is unacceptable & shows ways to help
- Worry chests in all classes
- School takes part in Anti-Bullying Week
- School Council discuss ways to support

What should I do if I see someelse is one being bullied?



- Don't walk away and ignore the bullying.
- Tell the bully to stop if it is safe to do SO.
- Don't stay silent or the bullying will keep happening. Tell someone.

The Head, the Governors, the staff and the Anti-bullying Team will work together to:-

- Make our school a safe place for all. That means no bullying is allowed.
- We will help everyone to get on with each other and we believe that everyone has the right to be who they are.
