

Something's

The Home Office has joined forces with charities including Childline, Barnardo's and The Children's Society to launch a new campaign to protect victims of child abuse. The month-long campaign, 'Something's Not Right',

encourages young people to recognise different forms of abuse, including sexual and physical abuse, report it and receive help. The campaign will see animated adverts aimed at secondary school pupils aged 13 and over, running across Instagram, Snapchat and Facebook. Young people will be directed to a dedicated page on the Childline website where they can access information and seek support. The campaign has been introduced in response to evidence that suggested young people faced a greater risk of sexual abuse, criminal exploitation and domestic abuse due to the impact of coronavirus (COVID-19).

On Monday we will celebrate the Feast of Christ the King.


NHS COVID-19 app, now available to download for free in England and Wales, is the fastest way to see if you're at risk from coronavirus. The faster you know, the quicker you can alert and protect your loved ones and community.




The app has a number of tools to protect you, including contact tracing, local area alerts and venue check-in. It uses proven technology from Apple and Google, designed to protect every user's privacy. If your postcode district becomes high risk, the app will let you know - and give you advice on what action to take.

- If you come into close contact with another user who reports a positive test result the app will send you an anonymous alert
 - A built-in QR scanner lets you check in to venues quickly and easily
- You can check your symptoms in the app and if they suggest you may have coronavirus, the app is an easy way to get tested
- Any data shared with the app is held on your phone
- Nobody will know who or where you are. You can delete the app and all data at any time
- The NHS COVID-19 app is the fastest way to see if you're at risk from the virus. The faster you know, the quicker you can alert and protect your loved ones.
