In Nursery we focus on promoting the 3 Prime Areas of Learning which are Personal, social and emotional development (making friends, selfcare and ability to follow instructions and routines), Communication and language (speaking, listening and attention) and Physical development (movement, pencil grip and toileting/dressing) so it would be wonderful if you could support your child at home in these areas also. In Nursery we believe communication is key to promote all other learning and development. The activities we do are to promote your child's speech and language skills. Homework will be sent out every Friday and please can you return this by the following Wednesday. Every half term we will hold a Stay and Play session were you will be able to interact with your child engaging in a range of activities within our provision.
