Coming back after lockdown, and after the children have been off school for so long, it is really important that the children are in school every day and that they complete the any homework they are given. There will be a set amount of homework each week which the children are required to complete and return to school the on the Friday of the week it is given. The children will be given a spellings on Monday, a reading comprehension on a Tuesday and a maths piece on Wednesday. Homework tasks should not take more than 30 minutes and we would encourage you to help your child wherever necessary, if however there are any problems, please don't hesitate to contact me either in person, by telephone or By contacting the year 4 email address. This year we will also be giving each child a home reading book which we ask you to read with your child at least 3 times a week for no more than 20 minutes. The children have logins for TTRS and as Year 4 children will take an official times table test this year, they should aim to go on to TTRS 3 times per week.

Children will have P.E every Wednesday and Friday and they should come into school in their PE kit. They must wear navy jogging bottoms for the winter months.
