I would like to take this chance to welcome you and your child into Year 5 'High Flyers' at St. Michael's Catholic Primary School.

After our time off, we are trying to get the children back and settled into the school as we can. The children have already settled in to the routines and are being pushed to work extremely hard! Our P.E. days this term are a Monday, and a Wednesday and we require that all children come to school wearing a dark navy tracksuit, training shoes and a t-shirt.
