I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you and your child into year 6 'Champions' at St. Michael's Catholic Primary School. The children have already settled in well and are working extremely hard!

Our **P.E.** day is a **Wednesday**, and we advise that all P.E. kits remain in school until the end of every half term when they should be taken home. Children are expected wear the school P.E. kit, or blue shorts and a plain white t-shirt, and will need trainers for outdoor lessons. No football kits are allowed.

Homework will be sent home each week on a **Monday**, and should be returned to school by **Friday**. The children will receive two pieces of homework per week, alternating between maths, English and topic
