It is essential that we have parents/carers up -to -date contact information. In light of Covid-19 it is vital we are able to contact you quickly if needed.

Measures to prevent the spread of Coronavirus

In line with government guidance we will:

- Minimise contact with individuals who are unwell by ensuring that those who have coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms, or who have someone in their household who does, do not attend school
- Clean hands thoroughly more often than usual and access to anti-bacterial gel
- Ensure good respiratory hygiene by promoting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach
- Continue with enhanced cleaning, including cleaning frequently touched surfaces often, using standard products such as detergents and bleach
