Dear Parents and Carers,

We have been asked by Liverpool City Council to raise awareness of the European Union Settlement Scheme. As the UK has now left the European Union, children from other European countries must complete an application and regularise their immigration status in order to stay in the UK. The deadline for this scheme is less than 5 weeks away (**30 June 2021**).

Applying to the scheme is very important as it means that people will protect the rights that they currently have, including the right to employment, to rent a home, and to access healthcare and benefits.

Citizens of these countries who are also parents must ensure that they also apply on behalf of their children, whether their children are citizens of the countries covered by the scheme or, if they are not citizens of those countries, their parent(s) is/are.
