<b>Main purpose of the role</b>	
To undertake cleaning within the school according to set procedures and tasked routines using a variety of methods including machinery.	
<b>Core responsibilities and tasks</b>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To undertake individually or as part of the team, the cleaning of designated areas to ensure they are kept in a clean and hygienic condition. Duties will include: Cleaning, washing, sweeping, vacuum cleaning, emptying litter bins, polishing and dusting of designated areas, which include toilet and associated facilities, fixtures and fittings, using where appropriate the necessary power equipment.</li> <li>2. To maintain and be responsible for the safe use and storage of all cleaning materials and equipment used in the course of these duties.</li> <li>3. To ensure that members of the public, visitors to the school etc. or any such persons are informed of any situation or circumstance that may affect their health and safety while cleaning operations take place.</li> <li>4. To ensure that statutory requirements, codes of practice and procedures relating to the Health and Safety at Work and any other relevant requirements are met in full.</li> <li>5. To provide cleaning cover for absent colleagues.</li> </ol>
