#### **Increased Covid Measures**

All schools in Liverpool have been asked to put into place increased Covid safe measures in light of the published substantial numbers of current Covid rates in Liverpool. We have updated our School Risk Assessment to reflect these recommendations. This is available here.

One of the key recommendations is ventilation –all areas including classrooms are to be well ventilated. Thus this means that classroom windows be need be open more than normal. During this colder weather you may want to put another layer of clothing on your child/children – extra vest/T shirt etc.

Please wear a face covering when dropping off and picking up at beginning and end of the school day - we must all work together to keep our school community safe.
