It was lovely to welcome the children back to school today. We understand this is an anxious and unsettling time so we will be fully supporting all the children through our ongoing pastoral programme that is age appropriate.

Today I met with a community police officer and her guidance for us all in the school and local community is to stay calm but alert and vigilant. If you have any concerns contact the police immediately. There will be increased police presence in the area to support and reassure the local residents.

In school we will re-visit our school safeguarding polices which includes our visitor policy. We will only be allowing people we know into school. Our entrance system has a camera and voice control so we are able to vet before we allow admission.

I will keep you updated.

## **Face Coverings**

A letter from Steve Reddy, (Director of Liverpool Children services) and Matt Ashton, (Director of Public Health) was sent from school in October about the worryingly high levels of Covid Infections in Liverpool, with highest numbers in school children.
