St. Michael's Remote Education Update

2021-2022



This information is intended to provide clarity and transparency to pupils and parents/carers about what to expect from remote education where individual pupils are self-isolating. If your child is not well enough to work, please let us know and we will not set any home learning activities.

If a child is working from home due to isolation, their teacher will provide work as closely inline with the work which would be completed in school, however some adaptations will need to be made. Dependant on the child's access to technology at home, work may be provided as a paper pack, or set via Google Classroom, our chosen online learning platform which the children accessed previously during the national lockdown. If accessing work online, there is an expectation that work will be set by the class teacher by 8.30 each day on Google Classroom, and should be completed and submitted by 3.30pm the same day.

If pupils are sent home during the school day, they will take with them a **reading book**, **passwords for relevant online learning platforms, and revision workbooks as appropriate**. Where needed, digital devices can also be loaned from school for the duration of the child's isolation.

Work can be completed by hand or electronically. If work is completed by hand you can take a photo and send this to the designated class email address.

In addition to the above, children should read every day and, where possible, should access the relevant online learning platform for their year group – TTRS, Reading Plus or Reading Eggs. Our school website also has a plethora of information and activities which will aid your child's remote education.

Alongside the set work, **staff will make contact with your child at least once per** week to check in and address any queries or concerns.
