FRIDAY 7.30pm C4 UNREPORTED WORLD

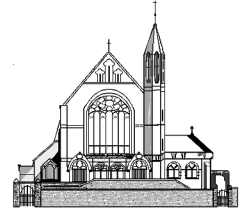
Investigates the unregulated and booming surrogacy market in the US and asks if the industry safeguards the vulnerable women making a living from it.
