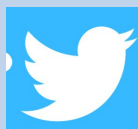

In the interest of your child's safety and well being we need:

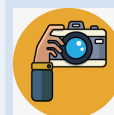
- \* a named adult that can be contacted at all times

Dear Parents and Carers

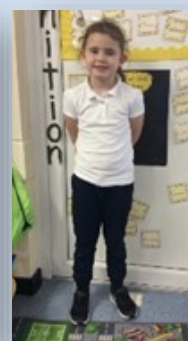
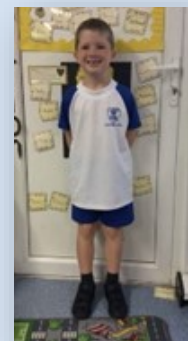
What a glorious Friday it was! The children have thoroughly enjoyed playing out today in this beautiful sunshine. What a treat for early October!

In our **Science** lessons, we have been finding out about the suitability of materials. We investigated a range of materials and discussed in groups what the properties of the materials were. We decided that glass is a suitable material for windows as it is transparent. This week we planned an investigation to test the strength of materials and we are very excited to carry out the investigation next week!
