
Staff update

Here are a couple of websites where you will find book recommendations, extracts of books and ideas to help you at home. Any chance you get to read with your child at home will make a huge difference.







May we be inspired by the miracles that your Son Jesus performed, To do our best to make a real difference to others around the world. **Amen**


