



# Radio Project for Liverpool Community Radio

Over the last 6 weeks Su Burke, a drama tutor currently working for Liverpool Community Radio, has been working with a group of Year 5 children on a special project.

The project looked at Covid 19 and explored how it has affected the children, their friends, families and the members of their communities. It was a fun, interactive and creative experience. It included elements of talking therapy as children were being encouraged to talk about their worries and concerns. They got to look back and open up about their experiences, and to look forward and talk about their hopes for the future.

Each session the children took part in role play, group discussion, writing and storyboarding. Week on week they grew in confidence, projecting their voices and embracing their roles.

The project culminated in a fantastic performance for their peers and a recording for Liverpool Community Radio. Their enthusiasm, commitment and attitude was excellent. We are very proud of them. Well done!

Every day there will be a meal available for every child that attends.
