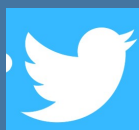

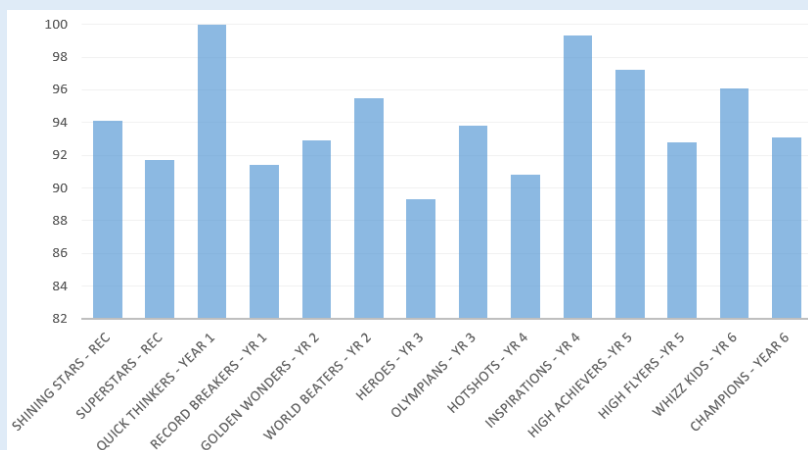

# Year 3—Olympians

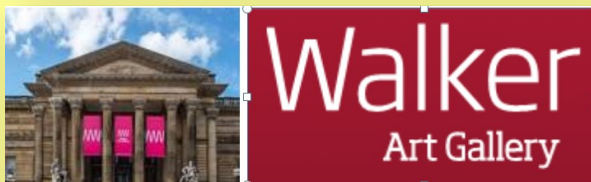

We visited the Liverpool Walker Art Gallery this week! On arrival we used our historical knowledge of what we have learnt about Ancient Greece and noticed how some of our Liverpool buildings like the Walker Art Gallery have been inspired by Greek architecture as we could see columns, pediments and friezes on them. We even saw a trident on a statue!

We talked about the paintings we observed and what we thought was happening in them as well as how the painting made us feel. We spoke about what aspects of the painting the artist had chosen to make light or dark and why.



In DT we have looked at different shell structures. We talked about what type of net and face each box has and whether they have a score part to help users open the boxes, lids or flaps.



In PE we have been developing our over-arm throwing and catching skills!

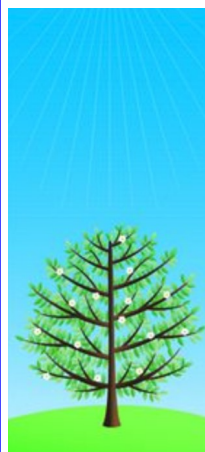

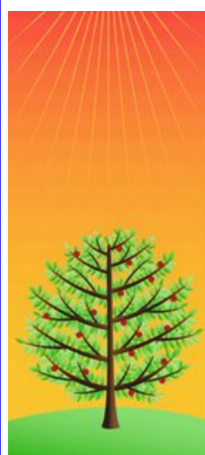
