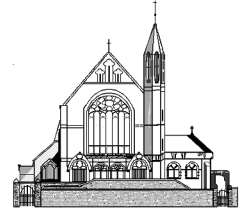

GOSPEL THOUGHTS Luke 20: 27-38

Will I recognize my grandad when I get to heaven? Will I be my 21yr old self or my 70 yr old self in eternity? What is 'life without death' like?

St Luke wrote his gospel after Jesus' death and resurrection. Enemies of Jesus had teased him about his hint of Eternal life. After the Ascension the early Christians trusted that life after death was to be our future. Enemies of the early church laughed at the notion of being alive after we had died.

Jesus' answer to his tormenters tries to help our small mindedness. He reminds them and us, that God had revealed to his chosen people, Abraham to Moses that to God 'we are all alive'. All our questions will be resolved when we are overcome by God's own life ;eternity.
