THURSDAY 9.00pm C4: DAVINA McCALL'S PILL REVOLUTION

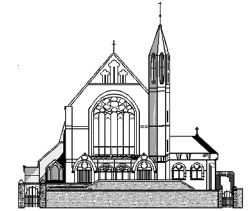
Examines the state of contraception in the UK and the struggle many women face to access it.

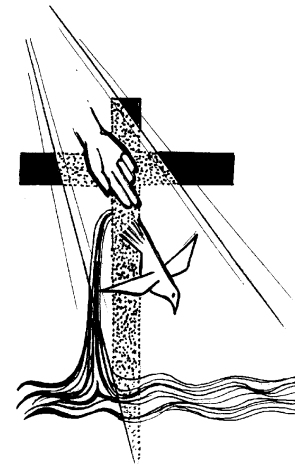
GOSPEL THOUGHTS
