### **Athletics City Wide Competition at Wavertree Park – 25<sup>th</sup> June**



Last Wednesday a large group of junior children took part in this competition. We competed against five other Liverpool Primary schools. They competed in the Long Jump, High Jump, 60 metre hurdles, 75 metres, 135 metres, 150 metres, 800 metres and 4 x 100 metre relay race. 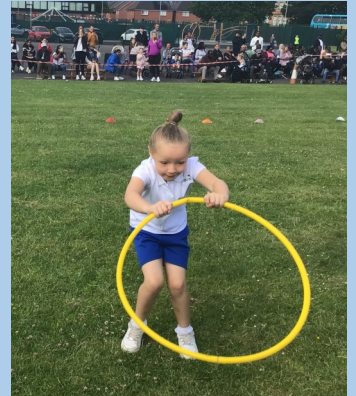

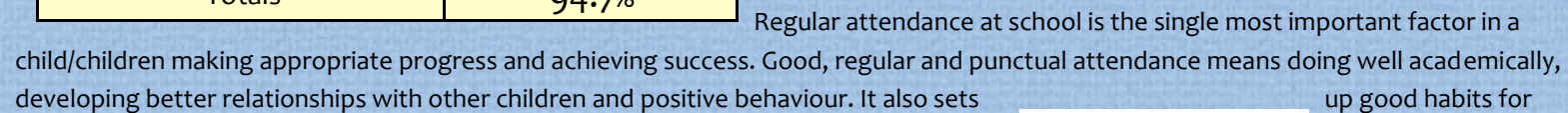

<b>Clothespins</b>	when 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blines have crusted over
<b>Droplettes and Swabbing</b>	48 hours after their last episode
<b>Gold and Purple Stems Antiviral Drug (IV)</b>	they no longer have a high fever or pain and feel well enough to attend school, the national pandemic protocol applies for COVID-19.
<b>Injections</b>	their scars have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
<b>Mucous</b>	4 days after the rash first appeared
<b>Mumps</b>	5 days after the swelling started
<b>Rashes</b>	they no longer have new ones
<b>Sore Throat</b>	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
<b>Whispering Cough</b>	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

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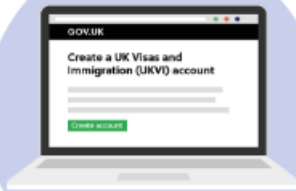
