If the soldiers come. I'll call for 'mum' and run. When I'm five. I hope to be alive. Will I look and be the same and see my name on the door frame? When I'm six. will someone find my body under bricks? Will I only be a name on the wall and the door or what remains of the floor.....? Pat McDonald
