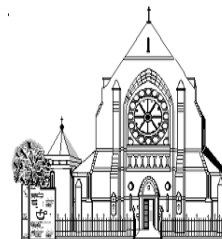

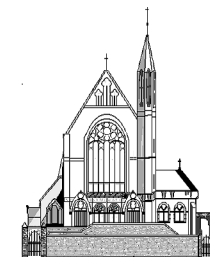

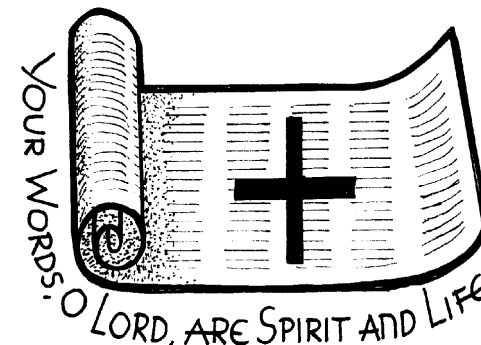

GOSPEL THOUGHTS: Luke 14:25-33

We would not run a marathon without training before hand. It would be foolish to go into an examination without preparing or swotting first. Our first reading reminds us that Wisdom has been given us to avoid our clumsy and often selfish way of dealing with each other. The father of the family shouted at his teenager, "You will do it my way while living in this house."

The Gospel passage, Jesus' very own teaching, is advising us to prepare and train ourselves for relating to our father or mother. "Hating" in Jesus time meant postponing; put in second place; prepare and train before acting. It is best to gather God's gift of wisdom; God's way of loving before planning and arguing.

To deal with anybody without coming from God's word first, is to give them less than the best.
