In June 2016, the UK voted to leave the EU. Ten years on, this documentary recounts the run-up to the referendum and the political fallout from the result.

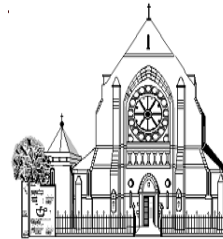
WEDNESDAY 10.00pm BBC2: EXPOSED: HIGH STREET CRIME CRISIS

FRIDAY 8.00pm C4: HUNTING THE DEBT PREDATORS

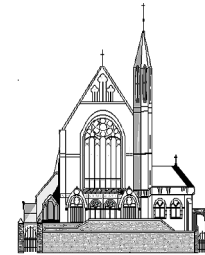

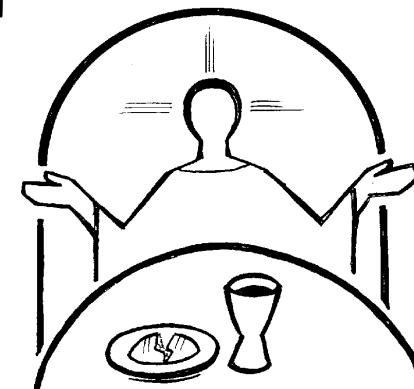
