Israeli Occupation Forces arrested Palestinian physician Dr. Mazen Al-Rantisi at his home in Ramallah. Israeli authorities have not announced the reasons for Dr. Al-Rantisi's arrest or disclosed where he is being held. Al-Rantisi is widely known throughout Palestinian cities, towns and villages as "Doctor of the Poor" because of his long-standing commitment to treating low-income patients and providing them with free affordable care.

Israel has arrested approximately 360 doctors and healthcare workers since 2023, the majority from Gaza. Approximately 82 remain in Israeli prisons.

Since October 2023, Israeli forces have killed 1,722 healthcare workers in Gaza alone, that is, approximately 2 healthcare workers every day!

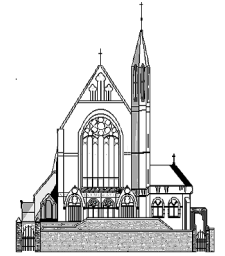

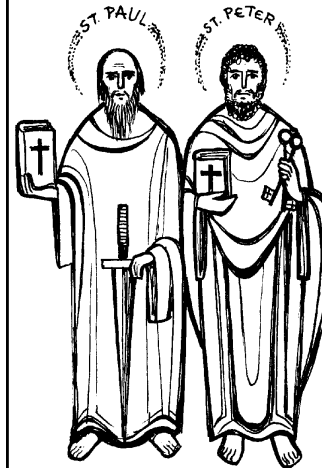
