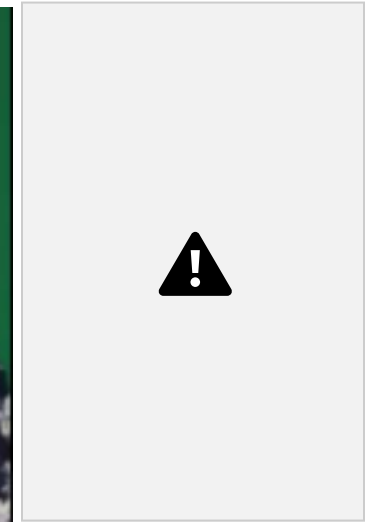

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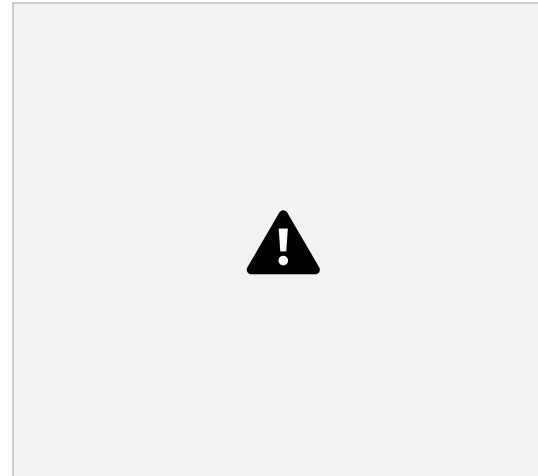

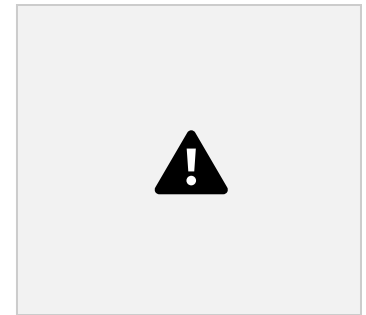

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PE is every Tuesday and Friday. A St. Michaels PE kit is required.



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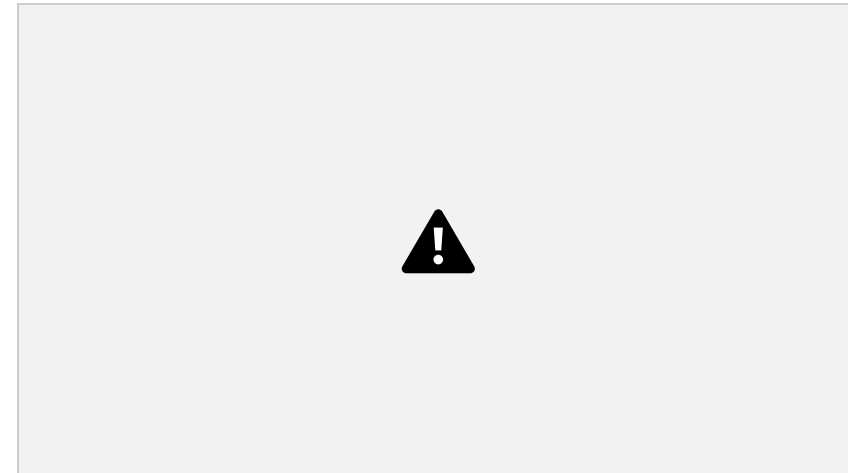
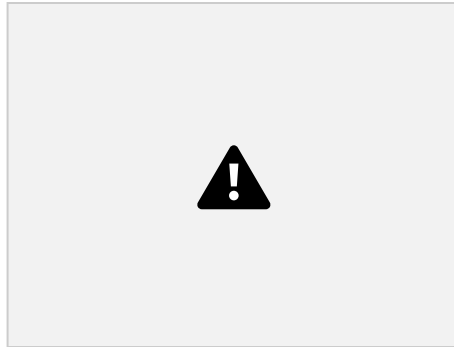
Phonics

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The content is age appropriate and is taught with sensitivity, taking into account the children's level of maturity in regard to the delivery of the lessons.

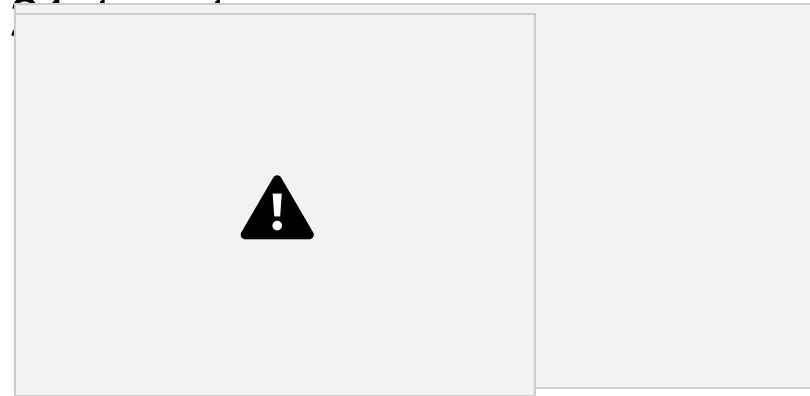
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Relationship and Sex Education (RSE)

Attendance and Punctuality – on time and attend school every day. Inform school morning absence to prevent home visit.

English – Encourage your child to read for pleasure. Good readers become good writers. Model good grammar/vocabulary. Learning weekly spellings.

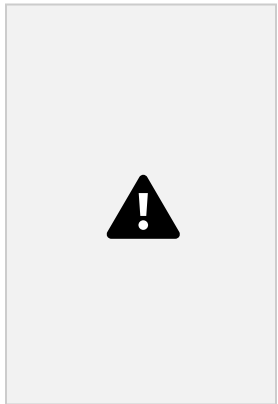
Maths - Basic skills – Times tables (All). Calculations - (All operations) Teach your child the time.

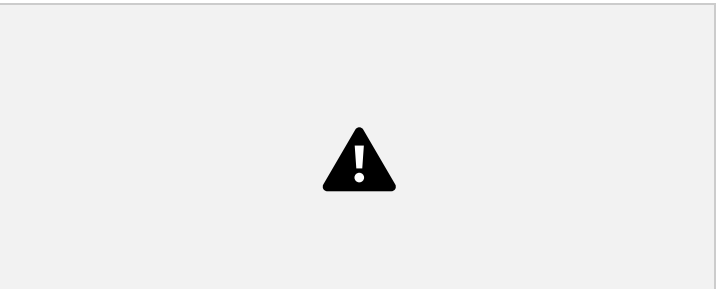
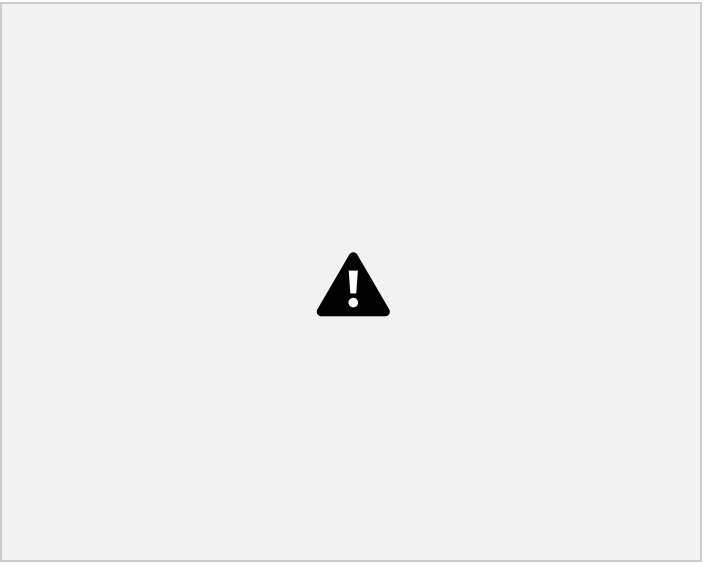

Sometimes our children require additional or different support to that of their peers. When this happens school will use a graduated approach to implement support. We use:

- High Quality First Teaching Approaches- (Wave 1) support
- Interventions with Learning Mentors (Wave 2)
- Specialist support from an outreach service like seedlings, speech and language, OT or an educational psychologist (Wave 3).

Children on the SEND register will receive an Intervention Ticket this year to inform you if they are starting an intervention with Learning Mentors.



Every child on the SEND register has a learning plan, with SMART targets, which you will receive before parents evening.

Pastoral Team

We help support the children with SEND interventions, emotional and social well-being, as well as wider family support. Please feel free to speak to us about any concerns or help you may need.

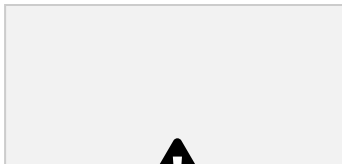

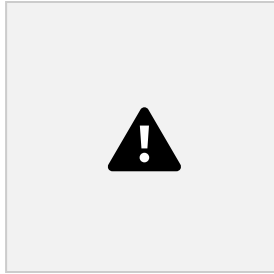

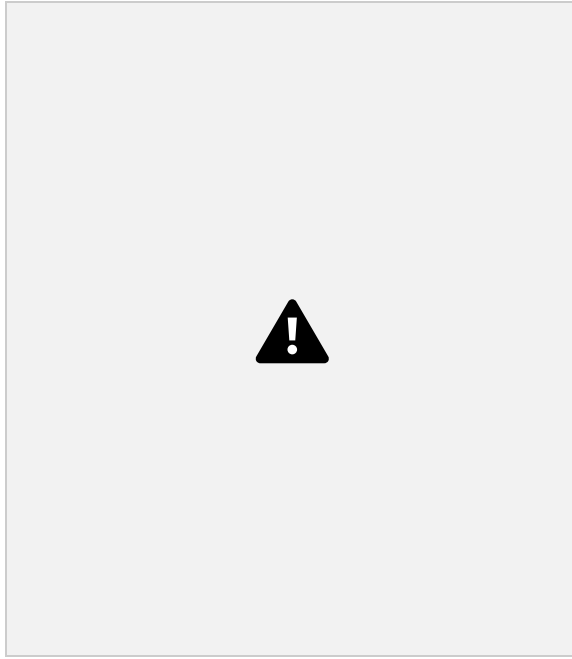

Online payment is accessible via Parent App- Arbor

Once you have logged into the Arbor App, you can make payments for School Meals, After School Clubs, Trips and other available payment options.

- **Pay weekly for School Meals** (Year 3, 4, 5 and 6): £10.00 per week.



- **After school Club-Sparkles**: available everyday for Reception to Year 6 children.
£4 Half session (3:30-4:30pm) and £7 Full session (3:30-5:30pm). This must be booked and paid in advance via Arbor.

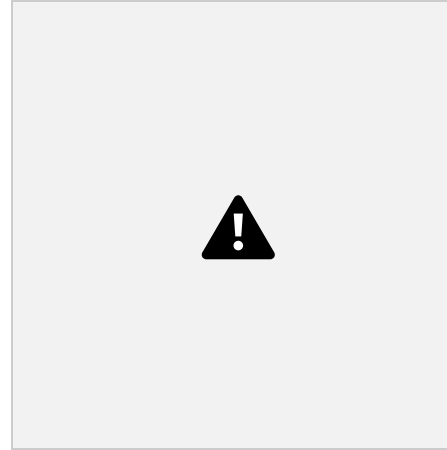

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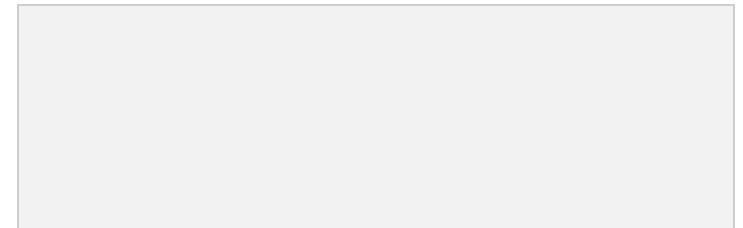

Heart Church.

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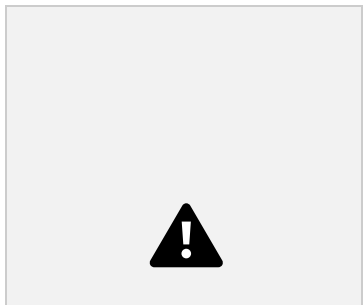
